Bethesda Cares Lunch Program – Help Needed

On the *second Sunday of every month*, as part of the Bethesda Cares lunch program, Redeemer is responsible for delivering 60 sandwiches to the Baptist Church on Wilson Lane in Bethesda. The sandwiches go towards feeding men who, during the week, come to there to get lunch. We buy Pepperidge Farm family style white bread (if available, other brand if not, but the Pepperidge Farm holds up better as the sandwiches are in the fridge for a few days); Oscar Mayer beef bologna; American cheese slices (not individually wrapped as they take too long to unwrap); 2 tubs Shedd's Country Crock margarine and 60 baggies with flaps. We make, bag and wrap the sandwiches and deliver them to the Baptist Church (at Wilson near the intersection of Old Georgetown Road) and put in one of the refrigerators in the kitchen (in the basement of the church). The Nelson family has generously volunteered to help us on Sunday, July 13, but we also need help for **Sunday, August 10**.
