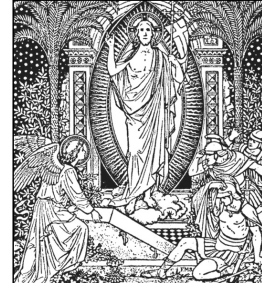
### **Organist Janet Yieh in Concert April 17 at 5:00 p.m.**
