The first event in our 2016-2017 Music at Redeemer series features the new thirteen member brass ensemble, The Barclay Brass, together with

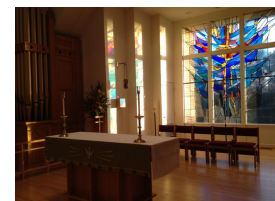
