



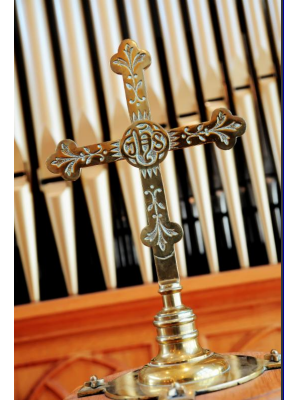

Founded during the fall of 2014 in Boston, Massachusetts, **The Heimat Quartet** is currently affiliated with Shenandoah Conservatory. Highlights from last season include the quartet's Carnegie Hall debut.

BEETHOVEN String Quartet No. 2 in G major, Op. 18, No. 2

Written in the final years of the 18th century, this early work from Beethoven's first set of quartets is rooted in 18th-century style. According to Steinberg, "In German-speaking countries, the graceful curve of the first violin's opening phrase has earned the work the nickname of *Komplimentier-Quartett*, which might be translated as 'quartet of bows and curtseys'."

MENDELSSOHN Quartet No. 2 in A minor, Op. 13

Composed by Mendelssohn in 1827 when he was 18, this quartet is one of his most passionate works, and is one of the earliest and most significant examples of cyclic form in music.
