Redeemer Book Group



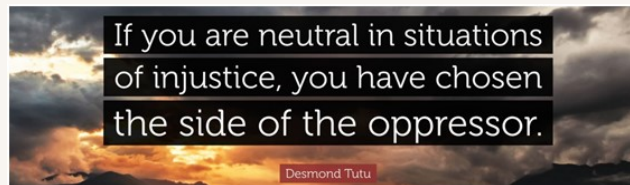
